**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 50**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “programs;” delete the rest of  
2 the line and delete line 3 and insert “creating new provisions; amending ORS  
3 329A.030, 329A.250, 329A.252, 329A.255, 329A.390 and 419B.005; repealing ORS  
4 329A.257; and prescribing an effective date.”.

5 On page 10, after line 30, insert:

6 **“SECTION 8. (1) As used in this section, ‘program’ means a pre-**  
7 **school recorded program or a school-age recorded program, as those**  
8 **terms are defined in ORS 329A.250.**

9 **“(2) Notwithstanding ORS 329A.030, a program may continue to**  
10 **employ an individual who is not enrolled in the Central Background**  
11 **Registry on January 2, 2022, if:**

12 **“(a) The individual was employed by the program on and before**  
13 **January 2, 2022;**

14 **“(b) The program completed a criminal background check for the**  
15 **individual before January 2, 2022;**

16 **“(c) The individual has submitted, or has agreed to submit, an ap-**  
17 **plication for enrollment in the Central Background Registry not later**  
18 **than June 30, 2022; and**

19 **“(d) The office has not issued a notice of intent to deny the**  
20 **individual’s application for enrollment in the Central Background**  
21 **Registry.**

1       **“(3) Notwithstanding ORS 329A.030, a program may continue to al-**  
2 **low an individual who is not enrolled in the Central Background Reg-**  
3 **istry on January 2, 2022, to volunteer in the program if:**

4       **“(a) The individual was volunteering in the program on and before**  
5 **January 2, 2022;**

6       **“(b) The program completed a criminal background check for the**  
7 **individual before January 2, 2022;**

8       **“(c) The individual has submitted, or has agreed to submit, an ap-**  
9 **plication for enrollment in the Central Background Registry not later**  
10 **than June 30, 2022; and**

11       **“(d) The office has not issued a notice of intent to deny the**  
12 **individual’s application for enrollment in the Central Background**  
13 **Registry.**

14       **“SECTION 9. The Office of Child Care may accept and process ap-**  
15 **plications for enrollment in the Central Background Registry that are**  
16 **submitted under section 8 of this 2021 Act and received by the office**  
17 **before, on or after January 2, 2022.**

18       **“SECTION 10. Sections 8 and 9 of this 2021 Act are repealed on**  
19 **January 2, 2023.**

20       **“SECTION 11. (1) Section 8 of this 2021 Act, the amendments to ORS**  
21 **329A.030, 329A.250, 329A.252, 329A.255, 329A.390 and 419B.005 by sections**  
22 **1 to 6 of this 2021 Act and the repeal of ORS 329A.257 by section 7 of**  
23 **this 2021 Act become operative on January 2, 2022.**

24       **“(2) The Office of Child Care and the Early Learning Council may**  
25 **take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1)**  
26 **of this section that is necessary for the office or council to exercise,**  
27 **on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this sec-**  
28 **tion, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the office**  
29 **or the council by section 8 of this 2021 Act, the amendments to ORS**  
30 **329A.030, 329A.250, 329A.252, 329A.255, 329A.390 and 419B.005 by sections**

1 1 to 6 of this 2021 Act and the repeal of ORS 329A.257 by section 7 of  
2 this 2021 Act.

3 **“SECTION 12. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**  
4 **date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative**  
5 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”**

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
