PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2594

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "sources" delete the rest of the line and insert a period.
- Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) The State Board of Forestry shall:
- "(a) Periodically review rules adopted under ORS 527.710 (2)(b) that relate to streams, channels and tributaries that have domestic water use.
- 8 "(b) Update the rules consistent with:
- 9 "(A) Current science;
- 10 "(B) Best management practices, as described in ORS 527.765; and
- "(C) Standards established under authority of the federal Safe
 Drinking Water Act and Clean Water Act to reduce risk and prevent
 degradation of waters used as drinking water sources.
- "(2) In performing the periodic reviews and determining if updates to the rules are needed, as required by subsection (1) of this section, the board shall:
- 17 "(a) Consult the Department of Environmental Quality and the 18 Oregon Health Authority.
- "(b) Request written input from the department and authority as to whether the rules need to be updated to prevent, alleviate or reduce environmental or public health impacts.

- "(c) Refer to the department all questions about the environmental impacts of the rules being reviewed.
- 3 "(d) Refer to the authority all questions about the public health 4 impacts of the rules being reviewed.
 - "(3) Upon request by the board pursuant to subsection (2) of this section, the department and authority shall provide written input to the board as to whether the rules need to be updated to prevent, alleviate or reduce environmental or public health impacts, based on current science and best management practices.
 - "(4) The board shall periodically assess whether the classification for streams, channels and tributaries that have domestic water use has been properly applied.
 - "(5) If the board determines, pursuant to subsection (4) of this section, that the classification has not been properly applied, the board shall remap the streams, channels and tributaries.
 - "(6) The board shall adopt rules establishing a process for determining whether additional watershed-specific rules are needed for watersheds that encompass a surface-based stream used as a source of drinking water and for which evidence indicates that forest practices pose a serious risk to continued use of the stream as a source of drinking water."

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
