**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 570**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 24, delete “or foundation”.

2 On page 2, delete lines 18 through 34 and insert:

3 “(7)(a) ‘Mattress’ means:

4 “(A) A resilient material or combination of materials that is enclosed by
5 a ticking, is used alone or in combination with other products and is in-
6 tended for or promoted for sleeping upon; or

7 “(B) A foundation.

8 “(b) ‘Mattress’ does not mean:

9 “(A) An unattached mattress pad or unattached mattress topper, with or
10 without resilient filling or ticking, that is intended to be used with or on top
11 of a mattress;

12 “(B) A sleeping bag;

13 “(C) A pillow;

14 “(D) A car bed, crib mattress or bassinet mattress;

15 “(E) A carriage, basket, dressing table, stroller, playpen, infant carrier,
16 lounge pad, crib bumper or other product manufactured for young children
17 or the pad for a product described in this subparagraph;

18 “(F) A water bed, an air mattress or another product that contains liquid-
19 or gas-filled ticking and that does not contain upholstery material between
20 the ticking and the mattress core; or

21 “(G) A foldout sofa bed, futon, futon mattress or upholstered furniture.”.

1 On page 3, line 18, delete “or foundation”.

2 In line 29, delete “or foun-”.

3 In line 30, delete “dations”.

4 In line 34, delete “or foundation”.

5 In line 37, delete “or founda-”.

6 In line 38, delete “tion”.

7 In line 42, delete “or foundation”.

8 In line 44, delete “or foundation”.

9 On page 4, line 2, after “organization” insert “with a plan approved by
10 the Department of Environmental Quality under section 6 of this 2021 Act”.

11 In line 8, delete “Department of Environmental Quality” and insert “de-
12 partment”.

13 In line 33, delete “or pay legal fees associated with legal action taken by
14 the state”.

15 On page 5, delete lines 37 through 41 and insert:

16 “(j) Provide a mechanism to mitigate the costs associated with collection
17 and management of discarded mattresses that are illegally dumped. The pro-
18 posed mechanism must take into account the cost of one or more incentives
19 to encourage collectors to properly dispose of discarded mattresses and dis-
20 courage illegal dumping, and may include but need not be limited to pro-
21 posals for funding of cleanup activities, for education and outreach or for
22 studies to evaluate the causes of illegal dumping. The proposed mechanism
23 may not require the stewardship organization or collectors to enter private
24 property without authorization from the property owner or other appropriate
25 authority.”.

26 On page 6, delete lines 37 through 41 and insert:

27 “(b) A plan may provide for methods for providing convenient service that
28 are alternative methods to those provided for in paragraph (a) of this sub-
29 section if, based on a geographic information systems analysis or additional
30 information, the alternative methods will result in providing service to resi-

1 dents throughout this state at an equivalent level of convenient service
2 compared with the methods provided for under paragraph (a) of this sub-
3 section.”.

4 On page 9, delete lines 3 through 6 and insert:

5 “(4) If the department determines that a change for which notice was
6 given under subsection (3) of this section has a material impact on a previ-
7 ously approved plan, the department may require the stewardship organiza-
8 tion to submit an amendment under subsection (1) of this section, regardless
9 of whether the change has been implemented.”.

10 In line 8, delete “four” and insert “five”.

11 In line 11, delete “four” and insert “five”.

12 Delete lines 33 through 41 and insert:

13 “(b) Information on the number and tonnage of discarded mattresses col-
14 lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program during the previous
15 calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to determine how the
16 program is performing in different regions of the state;

17 “(c) Information on the number and tonnage of program mattresses col-
18 lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program for recycling during the
19 previous calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to determine
20 how the program is performing in different regions of the state;

21 “(d) Information on the number and tonnage of program mattresses col-
22 lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program for renovation during
23 the previous calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to deter-
24 mine how the program is performing in different regions of the state;”.

25 On page 10, delete lines 6 through 11 and insert:

26 “(h) The number of discarded mattresses received through collection that
27 were not program mattresses, the number of discarded mattresses that were
28 illegally dumped as reported to the department, an analysis of how the data
29 required by this paragraph has changed over time and strategies the
30 stewardship organization will take to address discarded mattresses that are

1 not program mattresses and discarded mattresses that are illegally
2 dumped;”.

3 In line 27, delete “and foundations”.

4 On page 11, line 12, delete “four” and insert “five”.

5 In line 16, delete “four” and insert “five”.

6 On page 13, lines 10 through 12, delete the boldfaced material.
