## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2263

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall develop a plan to address the cost of tracking marijuana in this state.
At a minimum, the plan must:

"(a) Review the tracking systems and requirements of other states
in which recreational marijuana is legal;

"(b) Determine methods to reduce business costs associated with
tracking marijuana while continuing to meet the purposes of the system described in ORS 475B.177; and

"(c) Identify accountable alternatives to individual tagging of marijuana plants during the cycle of mature marijuana plant propagation to plant harvest in a manner that could be applicable to both marijuana and hemp tracking and would ensure that marijuana and hemp meet final product requirements for consumer and public health and safety.

"(2) Not later than June 30, 2022, the commission shall submit a
 report that details the plan, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245,
 to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to gov ernment.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 1,
2023.".
