**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2263**

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall de-**
3 **velop a plan to address the cost of tracking marijuana in this state.**

4 **At a minimum, the plan must:**

5 **“(a) Review the tracking systems and requirements of other states**
6 **in which recreational marijuana is legal;**

7 **“(b) Determine methods to reduce business costs associated with**
8 **tracking marijuana while continuing to meet the purposes of the sys-**
9 **tem described in ORS 475B.177; and**

10 **“(c) Identify accountable alternatives to individual tagging of**
11 **marijuana plants during the cycle of mature marijuana plant propa-**
12 **gation to plant harvest in a manner that could be applicable to both**
13 **marijuana and hemp tracking and would ensure that marijuana and**
14 **hemp meet final product requirements for consumer and public health**
15 **and safety.**

16 **“(2) Not later than June 30, 2022, the commission shall submit a**
17 **report that details the plan, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245,**
18 **to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to gov-**
19 **ernment.**

20 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 1,**
21 **2023.”.**
