PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 232

effective methods to diversify the educator workforce in this state.
The study must include reviews of:

 council, shall develop recommendations for:

"(a) Improving efforts to diversify the educator workforce in this

"(3) The department, in collaboration with the commission and the council, shall report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 1, 2021. The report shall include the results of the study conducted under subsection (1) of this section and the recommendations developed under subsection (2) of this section, and may include recommendations for legislation.".
