**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2172**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “provisions;” delete the rest
2 of the line and delete lines 3 through 5 and insert “and amending ORS
3 137.633.”.

4 Delete lines 7 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 22 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 137.633 is amended to read:

6 “137.633. (1) A person convicted of a felony or a designated drug-related
7 misdemeanor and sentenced to probation, **to post-prison supervision** or to
8 the legal and physical custody of the supervisory authority under ORS
9 137.124 (2) is eligible for a reduction in the period of probation or [*local*
10 *control*] post-prison supervision for complying with terms of probation or
11 post-prison supervision, including the payment of restitution and partic-
12 ipation in recidivism reduction programs.

13 “(2) The maximum reduction under this section may not exceed 50 percent
14 of the period of probation or [*local control*] post-prison supervision imposed.

15 “(3) A reduction under this section may not be used to shorten the period
16 of probation or [*local control*] post-prison supervision to less than six months.

17 “(4)(a) The Department of Corrections shall adopt rules to carry out the
18 provisions of this section.

19 “(b) The supervisory authority shall comply with the rules adopted under
20 this section.

21 “(5) As used in this section[:],

1 “[(a)] ‘designated drug-related misdemeanor’ has the meaning given that
2 term in ORS 423.478.

3 “[(b)] ‘*Local control post-prison supervision*’ means *post-prison supervision*
4 *that is supervised by a local supervisory authority pursuant to ORS 144.101.*]

5 “**SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 137.633 by section 1 of this**
6 **2021 Act apply to sentences imposed on or after the effective date of**
7 **this 2021 Act.**”.

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
