PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 219

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "directives" insert a period and 2 delete the rest of the line.

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'advance directive' has the
5 meaning given that term in ORS 127.505.

"(2) On or before September 15, 2022, the Advance Directive 6 Adoption Committee established under ORS 127.532 shall submit to the 7 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to judiciary 8 and health a report with recommendations for the development, 9 adoption and administration of a statewide advance directive registry 10 for the collection and dissemination of advance directives to help en-11 sure that medical treatment preferences for an individual nearing the 12 end of the individual's life are honored. 13

14 "(3) The recommendations under this section must:

15 "(a) Enable a principal, health care representative, attorney or 16 physician to submit the following documents to the registry:

- 17 "(A) A copy of a principal's advance directive;
- 18 "(B) A copy of a revised advance directive; and

¹⁹ "(C) Notice of any known revocation of an advance directive;

"(b) Prescribe the manner for submitting the information described
in paragraph (a) of this subsection;

"(c) Require the release of registry information to authorized users
 for treatment purposes;

"(d) Authorize notification by the registry to specified persons of
the receipt, revision or revocation of an advance directive;

5 "(e) Establish procedures to protect the accuracy and 6 confidentiality of information submitted to the registry; and

7 "(f) Address the integration of advance directives into electronic
8 medical records.

9 "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2,
10 2023.".
