PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 686

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

3 "(a) 'Facility ' means:

4 "(A) An acute or subacute hospital.

5 **"(B) A secure residential treatment facility.**

6 "(b) 'Patient' means a patient in a locked psychiatric unit of a fa-7 cility.

8 "(2) Except as provided in subsection (5) of this section, a patient 9 shall be provided the choice of having an in-person, face-to-face en-10 counter with a provider who is on site at the facility for the purpose 11 of prescribing psychiatric medications.

"(3) A facility must provide notice, orally and in writing, to a pa tient:

"(a) Of the patient's choice to see an on-site prescribing provider
 in person and not only through telemedicine; and

16 "(b) How to report, while the patient is in the facility or upon dis-17 charge, and to what authorities the patient may report a facility's 18 failure to provide the choice or to honor the patient's choice under 19 subsection (2) of this section.

"(4) A facility must document, in the patient's chart or otherwise,
 that the notice described in subsection (3) of this section was provided

1 and the patient's decision.

2 "(5) A facility may restrict a patient to a telemedicine encounter 3 with a prescribing provider if:

"(a) The facility is located in an area designated by the Oregon
Health Authority as a mental health provider shortage area and the
facility does not have an on-site prescribing provider available or an
on-call prescribing provider who can come to the site; or

8 "(b) There is a state of emergency declared for the area where the 9 facility is located or the area has experienced a natural disaster and 10 the facility does not have an on-site prescribing provider available or 11 an on-call prescribing provider who can come to the site.".

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
