<sup>2</sup> "<u>SECTION 1.</u> ORS 162.247 is amended to read:

"162.247. (1) A person commits the crime of interfering with a peace officer or parole and probation officer if the person, knowing that another person is a peace officer or a parole and probation officer as defined in ORS
181A.355:

"(a) Intentionally acts in a manner that prevents, or attempts to prevent,
a peace officer or parole and probation officer from performing the lawful
duties of the officer with regards to another person; or

"(b) Refuses to obey a lawful order by the peace officer or parole and
 probation officer that is necessary for the officer's performance of law ful duties with regard to another person or a criminal investigation.

"(2) Interfering with a peace officer or parole and probation officer is a
 Class A misdemeanor.

"(3) This section does not apply in situations in which the person is engaging in[:]

"[(a) Activity that would constitute resisting arrest under ORS 162.315;
 or]

19 "[(b)] passive resistance.

"(4) A person may not be arrested or charged under this section for
 conduct that would constitute any other criminal offense.".
