PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2221

- Delete lines 4 through 22 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
- "(a) 'State agency' means any state officer, board, commission,
- 4 corporation, institution, department or other state organization in the
- 5 executive or legislative department, as defined in ORS 174.112 and
- 6 **174.114.**

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- 7 "(b) Notwithstanding ORS 182.460, 284.118, 284.375, 377.836, 421.352
- 8 and 757.552, 'state agency' includes semi-independent state agencies
- 9 listed in ORS 182.454, the Oregon Tourism Commission, the Oregon
- 10 Film and Video Office, the Travel Information Council, the Children's
- 11 Trust Fund of Oregon Foundation, Oregon Corrections Enterprises and
- 12 the Oregon Utility Notification Center.
- "(c) 'State agency' includes a public university listed in ORS 352.002.
- 14 "(2) No later than 30 days after a state agency begins paying an
- employee an annual salary greater than \$250,000, the state agency shall
- 16 ensure that the following information is accessible to the general
- 17 public on the Internet:
- 18 "(a) The source of funds for the salary; and
- 19 "(b) An explanation of why the salary is justified based on wage
- 20 data for comparable positions.
 - "(3) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 is required to comply

with this section only with regard to positions funded with general funds available to the university that consist of student tuition and state appropriations.

"(4) A state agency subject to ORS chapter 240 satisfies the requirements of subsection (2) of this section if the Oregon Department of Administrative Services publishes the information required by subsection (2) of this section on the department's website at least biennially.

"(5)(a) A state agency subject to ORS chapter 240 shall report biennially to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services on employees subject to this section.

"(b) A state agency not subject to ORS chapter 240 shall report biennially to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly on employees subject to this section.

"SECTION 2. A state agency, as defined in section 1 of this 2021 Act, shall publish the information required under section 1 (2) of this 2021 Act for current employees of the state agency with salaries greater than \$250,000 no later than 30 days after the effective date of this 2021 Act.".

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
