PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3055

1 On page 42 of the printed bill, after line 15, insert:

"SECTION 71a. (1) To the extent necessary and permitted by state and federal law and Article IX, section 3a, of the Oregon Constitution, toll projects on interstate highways shall include investments to make improvements or fund efforts to reduce congestion as a result of the toll project, improve safety as a result of the toll project and reduce impacts of diversion as a result of the toll project.

"(2) Investments described in subsection (1) of this section may in clude but are not limited to multimodal investments on adjacent,
connected or parallel highways, regardless of ownership.

"(3) When making a decision about the design of a highway project,
the Department of Transportation shall consider how the effect of
implementing tolling may reduce:

14 "(a) Vehicle miles traveled; and

15 **"(b) The future capacity needs of the highway.**".

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
