## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2221

- Delete lines 4 through 22 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert:

- "(a) 'State agency' means any state officer, board, commission, corporation, institution, department or other state organization in the executive department, as defined in ORS 174.112, or legislative department, as defined in ORS 174.114.

  "(b) 'State agency' notwithstanding OPS
- "(b) 'State agency,' notwithstanding ORS 182.460, 284.118, 284.375, 377.836, 421.352 and 757.552, includes semi-independent state agencies listed in ORS 182.454, the Oregon Tourism Commission, the Oregon Film and Video Office, the Travel Information Council, the Children's Trust Fund of Oregon Foundation, Oregon Corrections Enterprises and

- "(c) 'State agency' includes a public university listed in ORS 352.002.
- "(2) No later than 30 days after a state agency begins paying an employee an annual salary greater than the amount determined under subsection (3) of this section, the state agency shall ensure that the following information is accessible to the general public on the Internet:
- 19 "(a) The source of funds for the salary; and
- 20 "(b) An explanation of why the salary is justified based on wage 21 data for comparable positions.

- "(3)(a) For calendar year 2022, subsection (2) of this section applies to annual salaries greater than \$250,000.
- "(b) Beginning in 2022, and every year thereafter, the Oregon De-3 partment of Administrative Services shall determine the percentage 4 increase or decrease in the cost of living for the previous calendar 5 year, based on changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban 6 Consumers, West Region (All Items), as published by the Bureau of 7 Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor. On or be-8 fore July 1 of the year in which the Oregon Department of Adminis-9 trative Services makes the determination required by this subsection, 10 the department shall adjust the annual salary amount to which sub-11 section (2) of this section applies for the following calendar year by 12 multiplying the annual salary amount applicable to the calendar year 13 in which the adjustment is made by the percentage amount deter-14 mined under this subsection. The adjusted annual salary amount ap-15 plies to payments to employees on or after January 1 of the subsequent 16 17 year.
- "(4) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 is required to comply with this section only with regard to positions funded with general funds available to the university that consist of student tuition and state appropriations.
- "(5) A state agency subject to ORS chapter 240 satisfies the requirements of subsection (2) of this section if the Oregon Department of Administrative Services publishes the information required by subsection (2) of this section on the department's website at least biennially.
- "(6)(a) A state agency subject to ORS chapter 240 shall report biennially to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services on employees subject to this section.
- 30 "(b) A state agency not subject to ORS chapter 240 shall report

- biennially to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the
- 2 Legislative Assembly on employees subject to this section.".

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
