**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2111**

1 On page 49 of the printed bill, after line 11, insert:

2 **“SECTION 44a. If House Bill 2264 becomes law, section 44 of this**  
3 **2021 Act (amending ORS 471.130) is repealed and ORS 471.130, as**  
4 **amended by section 5, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2021 (Enrolled House**  
5 **Bill 2264), is amended to read:**

6 “471.130. (1) Before selling or serving an alcoholic beverage to any person  
7 about whom there is any reasonable doubt of the person’s having reached 21  
8 years of age, a licensee or permittee shall require the person to produce one  
9 of the following pieces of identification:

10 “(a) The person’s passport issued by the United States or a foreign gov-  
11 ernment.

12 “(b) The person’s motor vehicle operator’s license issued by this state or  
13 another state of the United States or a province or territory of Canada.

14 “(c) An identification card issued under ORS 807.400.

15 “(d) A United States military identification card.

16 “(e) An identification card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe.

17 “(f) Any other identification card issued by a state or territory of the  
18 United States or province or territory of Canada that bears a picture of the  
19 person, the name of the person, the person’s date of birth and a physical  
20 description of the person.

21 “(g) Proof of the person’s participation in the Secure Electronic Network

1 for Travelers Rapid Inspection program operated by United States Customs  
2 and Border Protection, the NEXUS program jointly operated by that agency  
3 and the Canada Border Services Agency, or a successor to either of those  
4 programs that is recognized by the [*Oregon Liquor Control Commission*]  
5 **Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission.**

6 “(h) Any other form of identification as defined by the commission by  
7 rule.

8 “(2) If a person does not have identification as described in subsection (1)  
9 of this section, the permittee or licensee shall require the person to make a  
10 written statement of age and furnish evidence of the person’s true age and  
11 identity. The written statement of age shall be on a form furnished or ap-  
12 proved by the commission, including but not limited to the following infor-  
13 mation:

3 **Act (amending ORS 471.302) is repealed.”.**

5 **“SECTION 108a. If House Bill 2264 becomes law, section 108 of this**  
6 **2021 Act (amending ORS 471.478) is repealed.”.**

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
