**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5542**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) There is appropriated to the Department of**
4 **Transportation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
5 **General Fund, the amount of \$18,371,940 for debt service on the State**
6 **Radio Project and highway improvement projects.**

7 **“(2) There is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for**
8 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the**
9 **amount of \$14,400,000 for expenses related to debris removal associated**
10 **with the 2020 wildfire season.**

11 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
12 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
13 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**
14 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-**
15 **eral funds received as reimbursement from the United States Depart-**
16 **ment of Transportation, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds**
17 **not described in this section, collected or received by the Department**
18 **of Transportation, for the following purposes:**

20 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**
21 **funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2021 Act, collected**
22 **or received by the Department of Transportation, for the following**
23 **purposes:**

2 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
3 **the amount of \$125,155,188 is established for the biennium beginning**
4 **July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-**
5 **tery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic**
6 **Development Fund to the Department of Transportation for debt ser-**
7 **vice.**

8 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
9 **the amount of \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
10 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-**
11 **partment of Transportation from lottery moneys allocated from the**
12 **Veterans’ Services Fund established under ORS 406.140 to the Depart-**
13 **ment of Veterans’ Affairs and transferred to the Department of**
14 **Transportation for veteran transit services.**

15 **“SECTION 6. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures**
16 **by the Department of Transportation from federal funds for debt ser-**
17 **vice on Build America Bonds are not limited.**

18 **“SECTION 7. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures**
19 **by the Department of Transportation from the Oregon Transportation**
20 **Infrastructure Fund established under ORS 367.015 for debt service and**
21 **for internally reimbursed expenditures are not limited.**

22 **“SECTION 8. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**
23 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
24 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**

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
