SENATE BILL 5510**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page  
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
4 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
5 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**  
6 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**  
7 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**  
8 **Department of Consumer and Business Services for the following**  
9 **purposes:**

- 10 (1) **Workers’ Compensation**  
11 **Board ..... \$ 28,217,938**
- 12 (2) **Workers’ Compensation**  
13 **Division ..... \$ 49,148,715**
- 14 (3) **Oregon OSHA..... \$ 50,644,667**
- 15 (4) **Health Insurance Marketplace.. \$ 15,850,553**
- 16 (5) **Central Services Division..... \$ 50,859,275**
- 17 (6) **Division of Financial**  
18 **Regulation ..... \$158,988,103**
- 19 (7) **Building Codes Division ..... \$ 43,826,925**

20 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
21 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**

1 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**  
2 **funds collected or received by the Department of Consumer and Busi-**  
3 **ness Services for the following purposes:**

- 4 (1) Oregon OSHA..... \$ 13,457,541
- 5 (2) Health Insurance Marketplace.. \$ 1,813,619
- 6 (3) Central Services Division..... \$ 356,604
- 7 (4) Building Codes Division ..... \$ 29,152
- 8 (5) Division of Financial
- 9 Regulation..... \$104,441,874

10 **“SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the following**  
11 **expenditures by the Department of Consumer and Business Services**  
12 **are not limited:**

- 13 **“(1) Expenditures from the Workers’ Benefit Fund;**
- 14 **“(2) Expenditures from the Self-Insured Employer Adjustment Re-**  
15 **serve;**
- 16 **“(3) Expenditures from the Self-Insured Employer Group Adjust-**  
17 **ment Reserve;**
- 18 **“(4) Expenditures from the Consumer and Business Services Fund**  
19 **for payment of contracted collection costs, including contracted pro-**  
20 **cessing costs for the Combined Payroll Tax Reporting System and**  
21 **workers’ compensation paying agent reimbursements as described in**  
22 **ORS 656.307;**
- 23 **“(5) Expenditures from the Funeral and Cemetery Consumer Pro-**  
24 **tection Trust Fund; and**
- 25 **“(6) Special payments to Oregon Health and Science University for**  
26 **research on occupational illness and disease.**

27 **“SECTION 4. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
28 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
29 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**
