- 9 five consecutive years following the date on which the employment begins.
- 10 Failure to maintain residency in Malheur County for this period shall be
- 11 considered a voluntary termination of the employment.
- "(b) Paragraph (a) of this subsection does not apply to a resident appli-
- cant who elects in writing at the beginning of the application process to
- 14 forgo the preference available under this section.
- "(c) The Eastern Oregon Border Economic Development Board, in con-
- sultation with the governing body of Malheur County, may prescribe a
- 17 method by which employees holding civil service positions described in sub-
- section (2) of this section who received a preference under this section an-
- 19 nually notify their employers of the county in which their primary residence
- 20 is located. The notice shall include any documentation the board considers
- 21 necessary to confirm the residency and shall be made under penalties for

1 false swearing under ORS 162.075.".
