**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 3394**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, before the period insert “; and pre-  
2 scribing an effective date”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 5 through 10 and insert “shall provide an oppor-  
4 tunity for public comment.

5 “(5)(a) On or before March 1, 2022, the task force shall deliver a report  
6 on its progress to the standing or interim committees of the Legislative As-  
7 sembly related to rules.

8 “(b) No later than December 1, 2022, the task force shall submit a final  
9 report on its findings and recommendations, which may include recommen-  
10 dations for legislation, to the standing or interim committees of the Legis-  
11 lative Assembly related to rules.”.

12 In line 21, delete “Legislative Fiscal Office” and insert “Legislative Policy  
13 and Research Office”.

14 Delete lines 29 through 36 and insert:

15 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS chapter 461,**  
16 **during the time period beginning on the effective date of this 2021 Act**  
17 **and ending on January 2, 2023, the Oregon State Lottery Commission**  
18 **may not authorize, and the Oregon State Lottery may not implement,**  
19 **any lottery games playable on a mobile device, personal computer or**  
20 **other personal electronic device that were not authorized or imple-**  
21 **mented before the effective date of this 2021 Act.**

1       **“(2) Nothing in this section prohibits the Oregon State Lottery from**  
2 **entering into new contracts with video lottery game retailers, as de-**  
3 **fined in ORS 461.217, or carrying out existing contracts with video**  
4 **lottery game retailers.**

5       **“SECTION 4. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**  
6 **date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative**  
7 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
