SENATE BILL 5513**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 21 and delete pages  
2 2 through 4 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Educa-**  
4 **tion, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund,**  
5 **the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

8 **“SECTION 2. There are appropriated to the Department of Educa-**  
9 **tion, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund,**

11 **for program costs and to purchase services, for the following purposes:**

3            **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding ORS 327.856, there is appropriated to**  
4 **the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021,**  
5 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$174,618,343 for deposit in the**  
6 **High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Fund.**

7            **“SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Department of Education,**  
8 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the**  
9 **amount of \$48,238,961 for debt service on general obligation bonds.**

10            **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
11 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
12 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses, other than**  
13 **expenses described in sections 6 and 14 of this 2021 Act, from fees,**  
14 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**  
15 **cluding lottery funds, corporate activity tax funds and federal funds,**  
16 **collected or received by the Department of Education, for the follow-**  
17 **ing purposes:**

18            (1) Capital bonding ..... \$ 150,000,000

19            (2) Operations..... \$ 61,315,968

20            (3) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$ 6,598,468

21            **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
22 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
23 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of grants-in-aid, program**  
24 **costs and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues,**  
25 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, corpo-**  
26 **rate activity tax funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**  
27 **Department of Education for programs other than those specified in**  
28 **sections 5 and 14 of this 2021 Act, for the following purposes:**

29            (1) Early learning programs..... \$ 12,360,701

30            (2) Youth development programs \$ 6,331,117

- 2             Council ..... \$   50,375,000
- 3       (4) All other grants ..... \$   399,988,681

4       **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
 5 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
 6 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**  
 7 **funds, other than those described in sections 8 and 14 of this 2021 Act,**  
 8 **collected or received by the Department of Education, for the follow-**  
 9 **ing purposes:**

- 10       (1) Operations..... \$   156,608,600
- 11       (2) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$       329,420

12       **“SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
 13 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
 14 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of grants-in-aid, program**  
 15 **costs and purchased services from federal funds, other than those de-**  
 16 **scribed in sections 7 and 14 of this 2021 Act, received by the Depart-**  
 17 **ment of Education, for the following purposes:**

- 18       (1) Early learning programs..... \$   210,204,580
- 19       (2) Youth development programs \$       1,255,179
- 20       (3) Early learning COVID-19
- 21             related grants ..... \$   473,755,776
- 22       (4) K-12 COVID-19 related

25       **“SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
 26 **the amount of \$892,276,973 is established for the biennium beginning**  
 27 **July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payments of grants-in-aid,**  
 28 **program costs and purchased services by the Department of Education**  
 29 **from the Student Investment Account established under ORS 327.175.**

30       **“SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**

1 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July  
2 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payments of grants-in-aid, program  
3 costs and purchased services by the Department of Education from the  
4 Early Learning Account established under ORS 327.269, for the fol-  
5 lowing purposes:

- 6 (1) Early intervention services  
7 and early childhood special  
8 education programs ..... \$ 83,800,510
- 9 (2) Other early learning  
10 programs ..... \$ 348,136,610

11 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
12 the amount of \$4,169,563 is established for the biennium beginning July  
13 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-  
14 partment of Education from the Early Learning Account established  
15 under ORS 327.269 for operations.

16 **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
17 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July  
18 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payments of grants-in-aid, program  
19 costs and purchased services by the Department of Education from the  
20 Statewide Education Initiatives Account established under ORS  
21 327.250, for the following purposes:

- 22 (1) High School Graduation and  
23 College and Career  
24 Readiness Fund ..... \$ 136,682,685
- 25 (2) Reengagement program ..... \$ 8,344,000
- 26 (3) Statewide equity initiatives... \$ 22,688,000
- 27 (4) All other grants ..... \$ 167,230,199

28 **“SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
29 the amount of \$35,956,536 is established for the biennium beginning  
30 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the

1 Department of Education from the Statewide Education Initiatives  
2 Account established under ORS 327.250 for operations.

3 **“SECTION 14. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the follow-  
4 ing expenditures by the Department of Education are not limited:**

5 **“(1) Moneys from the School Lunch Revolving Account, Education  
6 Training Revolving Account and Common School Fund; and**

7 **“(2) Expenditures for grants-in-aid and purchased services from  
8 federal funds received by the Department of Education from the  
9 United States Department of Agriculture.**

10 **“SECTION 15. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate  
11 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
12 declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**

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
