Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 10 the amount of \$2,564,210 is established for the biennium beginning July 11 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery 12 moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-13 opment Fund to the State Forestry Department for debt service re-14 lating to the purchase of land in the Gilchrist Forest.

15 "SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 16 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 17 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal 18 funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2021 Act, collected 19 or received by the State Forestry Department, for the following pur-20 poses:

26 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-27 priation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the 28 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount 29 of \$14,000,000, to be allocated to the State Forestry Department for fire 30 protection expenses. "(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this
section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December
1, 2022, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any
purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

5 "SECTION 6. There is appropriated to the State Forestry Depart-6 ment, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, 7 the amount of \$3,816,424, for fire protection, for payment of cat-8 astrophic wildfire insurance premiums for the 2021 fire season.

9 "<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate
10 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
11 declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.".
