**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2932**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

4 **“(a) ‘Law enforcement unit’ has the meaning given that term in**
5 **ORS 181A.355.**

6 **“(b) ‘Local correctional facility’ has the meaning given that term**
7 **in ORS 169.005.**

8 **“(c) ‘Peace officer’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 161.015.**

9 **“(2) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall establish a**
10 **statewide database of reports of the use of physical force by peace of-**
11 **ficers and deaths in custody of law enforcement units. The database**
12 **must be searchable and available to the public.**

13 **“(3) For each instance in which a peace officer employed by a law**
14 **enforcement unit uses physical force against an individual, or when a**
15 **death occurs while an individual is in the custody of a law enforce-**
16 **ment unit, the law enforcement unit shall report to the commission**
17 **and to the Federal Bureau of Investigation as soon as practicable, but**
18 **no later than 72 hours after the use of force or death in custody:**

19 **“(a) The following information about each officer who used physical**
20 **force:**

21 **“(A) Name.**

- 1 **“(B) Certification number.**
- 2 **“(C) Race.**
- 3 **“(D) Gender.**
- 4 **“(E) Age.**
- 5 **“(F) Height and weight.**
- 6 **“(G) Years of experience.**
- 7 **“(H) Whether the officer is a full-time or part-time employee.**
- 8 **“(I) Whether the officer was readily identifiable.**
- 9 **“(b) The certification numbers of all officers present at the incident**
10 **who did not use physical force.**
- 11 **“(c) The date, time and location of the use of physical force.**
- 12 **“(d) The perceived race, gender, age, religion, height and weight of**
13 **the person against whom physical force was used.**
- 14 **“(e) A description of the physical force used.**
- 15 **“(f) A description of the severity of the physical force used.**
- 16 **“(g) A description of any injuries sustained by officers and persons**
17 **against whom physical force was used.**
- 18 **“(h) Whether the officer who used physical force was on duty.**
- 19 **“(i) Whether the officer who used physical force used a weapon or**
20 **discharged a firearm.**
- 21 **“(j) Whether the use of physical force was investigated by the law**
22 **enforcement unit or the Department of Public Safety Standards and**
23 **Training, and the outcome of the investigation.**
- 24 **“(k) Whether a citizen complained about the use of physical force,**
25 **and the outcome of the complaint.**
- 26 **“(L) Whether the law enforcement unit initiated the contact that**
27 **ended in the use of physical force.**
- 28 **“(m) Whether officers were ambushed.**
- 29 **“(n) Whether a supervisor was present during the use of physical**
30 **force.**

1 **“(o) The reason for the presence of officers at the incident that**
2 **ended in the use of physical force.**

3 **“(p) Whether the person against whom physical force was used re-**
4 **sisted.**

5 **“(q) A description of any threats against officers or others made**
6 **by the person against whom physical force was used.**

7 **“(r) Whether the person against whom physical force was used ap-**
8 **peared to be impaired.**

9 **“(4) A law enforcement unit may not report to the commission the**
10 **name, address, Social Security number or other unique personally**
11 **identifiable information of a person against whom physical force was**
12 **used.**

13 **“(5) At least once each calendar quarter, the Department of Cor-**
14 **rections and a local correctional facility shall submit to the commis-**
15 **sion data related to deaths in custody collected under and on forms**
16 **established by the Bureau of Justice Statistics of the United States**
17 **Department of Justice in accordance with the federal Death in Custody**
18 **Reporting Act (P.L. 113-242).**

19 **“(6) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall report annually**
20 **to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative**
21 **Assembly on the reports received under this section, aggregated and**
22 **broken down by law enforcement unit.”.**

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
