I oppose House Bill 2833; Oregon Hunger Task Force was enacted 1989 (ORS 458.532) THIRTY-TWO YEARS (32) TOTAL. Currently the Task Force has a staff of 11. There are 28 seats for non-profit partners for Hunger Free Oregon. I have lived my entire life 6+ decades and never heard of the State mandated organization. In other words, it takes 11 paid employees of the task force to organize 28 member non-profit partners. DISBAND the Oregon Hunger Task Force it is a waste of revenue just for organization of the 28 volunteer members Advisory Board.
