My name is Vanessa, I live in Portland, and I am writing in support of HB 2357 to eliminate the Oregon Forest Resources Institute and Fund, due to their suppression of significant scientific data related to the connection between logging practices and environmental impacts. We should not fund an organization that produces biased, misleading, and at times completely incorrect 'reports' in order to funnel support into the logging industry. The impacts of clear-cut logging need to be acknowledged in order for us to find meaningful solutions to the slew of environmental issues plaguing our local and regional communities, our wildlife, our watersheds, and our global climate.
