Thank you Chair Witt and Committee Members,

I am Matt Stevenson and I live on stolen Multnomah, Kalapuya, Cowlitz, Clatskanie, Clackamas, and Molalla land, and I urge you to advance HB 2357, which would eliminate the Oregon Forest Resources Institute (OFRI) and Oregon Forest Resources Institute Fund.
