My name is Bri Condon and I serve as the Executive Director of Bradley Angle. I am writing to ask for your help and support for HB 2551 to ensure Oregon invests in the vitality of our communities, by supporting the Oregon Individual Development Account (IDA) Initiative's request for funding to support Oregonians in achieving the dream of homeownership, higher education, starting a business, and other goals.

As you know poverty but also asset poverty has substantially placed a generational burden on many domestic violence survivors of color in our state. IDAs are one of the few existing tools we have to help meet urgent needs and support an equitable recovery from COVID-19 impacts and for many who were affected by wildfires. IDAs are already in place and ready to make a difference in our community.

I ask that you support HB 2551 in renewing the IDA Initiative Tax Credit for the next six years. The IDA Initiative would not be able to accept new savers without your action in 2021. Your support would allow individuals and families from every corner of the state to begin saving for a better future and would help those who are hardest hit by the financial hardships that the spread of COVID has created.
