

**Testimony of the Oregon State Bar  
in Support of SB 297  
Before the Senate Judiciary and  
Ballot 110 Measure Implementation Committee  
January 27, 2021**

Chair Prozanski, Members of the Committee,

The Oregon State Bar has a three-pronged mission that includes protecting the public by regulating the legal profession, supporting the judiciary and improving the administration of justice, and ensuring that Oregon maintains a fair, inclusive and accessible justice system.

Providing access to justice requires having a well-functioning judicial branch at every level. Ensuring that the Oregon Judicial Department has highly trained and qualified staff is every bit as important as their ability retain highly qualified judges. SB 297 is one small but important step that will help the courts protect public safety and better meet the needs of Oregonians by helping them recruit and retain highly qualified judicial marshals.
