Dear Committee Members,


My name is Erin J. Wooding and I have been an Esthetician since 2007 and a Certified Advanced Esthetician (CAE) in Oregon since 2016. I am also a local business owner of 14 years and employ a regular Esthetician. I am writing this letter in support of HB2970 and HB2971.

HB2970 would restore the use of devices that are commonly used in the esthetics industry. The ability to use these devices were unintentionally taken out of the basic esthetics scope of practice. We desperately need this bill to pass. It must be restored so that thousands of fellow, regular Estheticians are able to support themselves and their families.

I strongly support HB2971 which would abolish the Certified Advanced Esthetics Board. This would move regulation of the CAE license back to the Cosmetology Board which would illustrate a financial savings and give back balance and equality to our profession. I agree that an advisory committee of experts would/could be used if the need should arise.
