

As an esthetician I support this bill. By approving this bill we can continue to be allowed to use the devices we have been using for years. These devices are critical to our abilities as estheticians to perform the services we provide. To have these devices removed from our scope of practice would greatly impact our ability to continue providing the services we currently offer.

This bill will also define the scope of practice for eyebrow and eyelash services which is a grey area right now.

I feel this bill gives a much better clarification on scope of practice and brings together the Board of Cosmetology and the Board of Advanced Estheticians which is greatly needed for the coherency and consistency of the scopes of practice to be inline with each other.

The impact of this bill not passing and leaving Esthetics and advanced Esthetics with reduced and conflicting scopes of practice can cause legal and financial hardship on the Estheticians who have been trained and using these devices for years.
