Chair Power, Vice Chairs Reynolds and Zika, and Committee members,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide written testimony in support of HB 3109: Regarding Child Care Facilities. On behalf of the Bend Chamber's 1,500 business members we thank Representative Zika for bringing the bill forward this session to support our local community.

Access to quality, affordable child care is one of the strategic goals of the Bend Chamber's advocacy program. As you heard in committee today, the Chamber helped to develop and fund the Child Care Accelerator Program to address the child care desert which exists in Central Oregon. The child care industry has been devastated as a result of COVID. Prior to the pandemic there was only one available opening for every three children in Central Oregon. It is much, much worse today with many child care providers unable to weather the economic turmoil.

The bill proposes a reasonable and thoughtful solution to reduce the regulatory and cost burden for child care providers and those looking to enter the market. Allowing childcare to be located close to where people work is essential to employees with families and helps businesses attract and retain talent. Increasing available locations in commercial and industrial zoned areas, as outlined in the bill, will help providers to find more options to meet the growing needs of families to find quality childcare.

We appreciate the spirit of the proposed amendment discussed today to remove entities that are already regulated in statute, and will strongly support the amended bill and encourage passage.
