"Text," [SB 776] exert: "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 332. SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 247.016 (2) or 255.005 (6), an individual may vote in all school district elections, including the nomination and election of school directors, if the individual: (a) **Is 16 or 17 years of age;**... (b) To the extent practicable, the ballot style that is used to create ballots for individuals described in subsection (1) of this section is the same as the ballot style used in other ballots for the same school district elections."
