I am writing today to voice my opposition to SB223. For the last 13 years, I chosen to send my children to private Christian schools in Oregon. There are many reasons for that, not all because of my deeply held Christian faith. A portion of my property, state, and federal tax dollars go to support the local public schools, but there is not any of that money that goes to the private schools in our state.
