While Ranked Choice Voting methods solve the most important issue with voting, the inability to express a real preference for the candidate they wish they would win without risk of contributing to the candidate they most oppose winning over the voter's 2nd best choice, this proposed measure would lock out an even better method.

I prefer the STAR Voting method, as it has a few technocratic advantages over the more broadly known RCV method. Specifically, better allowance of earlier and local tallying of votes within precincts or single elections offices is possible with STAR but not with RCV.
