

Vote No on SB 223

Based on the First and Fourteenth Amendments, Private Schools have the Right and Freedom to exist, and to exercise jurisdiction over their own schools.

Private Schools do not contract with Public School Districts for services, and should not be pressured into registering with ODE in order to participate in interscholastic sports, nor should they be penalized for engaging in extracurricular activities with non-private schools. Private Schools do not receive remuneration or services from public school districts by competing in sports with them. There is no need to impose unnecessary restrictions on Private Schools and deny them the freedom of complete jurisdiction over their Schools. We say NO to SB 223.
