

I am writing in support of HB3239, establishing common sense limits/restrictions on where cannabis may be processed. The cannabis processing facility on Chehalem Mountain poses a distinct threat to the residents of the area with regard both to depletion of our aquifer from the anticipated degree of water draw from this facility, as well as the increased potential for fire risk and the severe consequence of any fire events in our area, as has been harshly demonstrated last September with the wildfire that occurred here. An industrial facility using highly flammable solvents should not be allowed/zoned in a highly forested, residential and agricultural area such as ours.
