As an educator for over 20 years in both public and private schools, I am compelled to express my strong opposition to SB 223 Legislation regarding private schools being subject to the State of Oregon rules and regulations that would essentially make them into public schools. Since the State of Oregon does not fund private schools, the Oregon Department of Education should not have any jurisdiction regarding the private education system in this state.
