Please vote against SB 223. I am greatly concerned that this bill would severely limit parental choice in education. Forcing private schools to register with the state would create expensive and intrusive oversight into private schools, essentially turning them into public schools. My son had learning challenges and greatly benefited from both the Early Intervention program, homeschool and private school education.
