My children attended Crosshill Christian School for all of their high school years. We transferred them there after a very tragic run at a our local public school. The public school was too big to and impersonal. They were getting lost educationally, relationally & were failing across the board. One of my sons was on their way to not graduating high school, per the school public school counselor. Once placed in a private intimate school setting the blossomed. Including sports & music, even leading their school to #3 in state for basketball. They learned how to study & work very hard & then in return succeed academically. It brought them back by reinforcing everything we had taught them their whole lives. I can't imagine where they would've ended up if they had not switched to a private school. Our faith is what we've built our lives on, this option of private school was our last hope. It's important to my family & other families to find an educational setting that fit their believes & educational style as well as smaller settings.
