

Logging is Oregon's coal industry. This is the conclusion of several studies which reveal that industrial logging- not transportation of heating/cooling - is by far the largest source of Green House Gas emission in the state of Oregon. Meanwhile the Oregon Board of Forestry is in complete denial of this science.

Does the Oregon Senate really want to take any meaningful action to arrest climate change? If so, the science is clear that the most impactful way to halt Climate Change in Oregon is to seriously reform Oregon's logging practices. Yet, this will simply not happen under the current composition and charge of the Board of Forestry. SB 335 takes a step toward ensuring that this will change.
