On the State level of Legislative Assembly changing two-thirds (2/3) to a "majority" would be a disservice to the citizens of this State. Nor would I condone or vote for the State legislative assembly to change the Oregon Constitution to allow majority and/or reconciliation at the Oregon State level. Therefore, I oppose Senate Joint Resolution 4.
