

## I STRONGLY OPPOSE

This bill basically creates a state-level student council of non-white students to help direct educational policy. Excludes membership of the 85% majority of students in Oregon based solely on their Euro-American ethnicity. Where is the representation for "white" economically disadvantaged?

The purpose of this council is to serve at the will of the Governor to make recommendations on educational policy, force racial diversity in local public school student government bodies (in a state that is 85% white, and more than that in rural areas), establish "hotlines" to provide students with "supports and resources," and reimburse Oregon Department of Education for their support of such a council. The council even makes recommendation to the Early Learning Division and the Youth Development Division on education police on racial equity and justice at local level, as if they have expertise.

Our schools are graduating indoctrinated kids that are being taught what to think and how to think. When kids get a taste of power they can't direct it in a logical way. This experience can be provided locally in a directed environment.
