

I enjoy going to a movie theater to see a good film. I do not enjoy watching movies on tv. I don't fee that it's fair that other entertainment groups have received financial assistance during the shutdown while movie theaters have not.

And independent theaters didn't have the financial reserves that the major theater chains must have had in order to keep their leases and pay other fixed expenses while also being closed.

Unlike most other businesses, theaters experienced a total shutdown for nearly a year.

Theaters were not included in the \$25 million that went to live performance venues last year.

Theaters face a long road to recovery without new film productions.

Even with greater capacity allowances (50% and above), theaters will still be limited to roughly 25% capacity due to 6' social distancing requirements.

Funds are needed to help address fixed costs incurred while theaters were required to be closed and capital expenses related to re-opening.
