Text HB 3245: SECTION 3. (1) An eligible business may deliver, or cause to be delivered, malt beverages, wine or cider to a final consumer only by using a delivery person.

(2) A retail sales agent may deliver, or cause to be delivered, distilled liquor to a final consumer only by using a delivery person.
