will help me become the person I'd like to be.

I have completed Pathfinders/Parenting Course

I also completed "GOGI" and I've attended "Coda" Class's. GOGI is a positive Decision making tool class, "Coda" is a 7<sup>th</sup> Step Codependent Class. I also attended "NVC" no-violent Communication Class. With a weekly Alcoholics Anonymous and narcotics Anonymous meetings. All of these class's and meeting and courses are extremely beneficial for personal growth and change. I've got so much out of each one, things I've never knew about my Self and different tools to help navigate life. I Choose to be good, I Choose to better my self, I want to be positive. I've changed the way I think, the thoughts I have. I've turned my positive thoughts into positive actions, I do not get any good time for these thing, I have not had any Cell-ins, daily falls for performance, or any misconduct reports. I do not get any good time for 100% Clear conduct. I feel AIC's that are Changing their lives through programming Should earn good time. I believe this will benefit both AIC's and the Community. It is not a secret that some measure ll AIC's do nothing to change because they have nothing to gain from it and nothing to lose from getting into more trouble. That's because they think they have nothing to earn. In alot of cases that means that they stay stuck in their old ways or worse.
