IN RE: Testimony in Support of Senate Bill 651


Dear Committee Members:

Kindly accept this letter as my testimony in favor of Senate Bill 651 which would "... provide that probationer or probationer's attorney may file [an] objection to [a] proposed modification to [probationer's] special conditions of probation."

Under the United States and Oregon State Constitutions, all citizens must be afforded due process in criminal prosecutions and any consequences thereof. Senate Bill 651 does no more than codify, and explicitly acknowledge, the right of convicted persons to appropriately challenge proposed changes to their conditions of supervision. This bill is a no-brainer; it should need no debate.
