My name is Brooke Keppler and I am currently serving a twelve and a half year sentence under Measure 11. My letter to you today is about SB191. I am in favor of keeping it retroactive and wanted to write this letter to you to voice my thoughts about the bill.

Society has labeled inmates as monsters, burdens on society, dangerous and third class citizens and such. This has mainly been fueled by the Media and Press trying to sway the opinion of Law Makers, Tax Payers and Voters into believing that we are broken and unrehabilitatable. To some this is true, but just like that old saying "One bad apple spoils it for the whole bunch". You have those that can't follow the rules and are in and out of Prison serving yet another sentence on a 3rd or 4th offence for the same crime. Now there are a great deal of inmates who could benefit from this incentive of good time, who follow the rules and just want a second chance to prove themselves. I would love the opportunity to prove myself. Most people out there will never know the struggles of life on the inside. Giving a person hope and an incentive to be good is a big part of rehabilitation.

Another issue I want to bring to your attention is Mental Health. I am a firm believer in holding people accountable for their actions, but what I don't agree with is the amount of time that's being handed out under ballot Measure 11. Measure 11 is damaging our community

and I feel a good amount of energy.

Most offenders got hit with so much time that even giving them 20% good time will still leave them serving quite a lengthy sentence. Measure II is too harsh of a punishment for first time offenders. Locking a person down for decades that are rehabilitatable is hazardous to their Mental Health and State of Mind.

In closing I just want to say that the greatest reward for me would be to be a part of my kids life again. My boy's need me and I need them. Please take into consideration all the families who's lives you could change. Giving an inmate hope and motivation to keep doing good and make the right decisions play's a huge role in the reason we are here in the first place, Rehabilitation. Thank you for your time.
