

The information presented by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission (OCJC) is dated, where they cite costs and technological concerns from 2015. Mandating a cloud-based depository and using programs for redacting are all now common in the major cities throughout the US. HB 2571 was already passed in 2015 to outline the specific concerns of retention, and usage of the material captured. I recommend that a more technology-savvy commission to be in charge of the study, since the OCJC seems ill equipped to proceed with conducting relevant information needed.
