

Please support the Oregon Right to Rest Act. Oregon has experienced the largest increase in homelessness of any state, thanks to low wages, increasingly higher housing prices & job loss during the pandemic. Once the CDC moratorium on evictions is lifted, the homeless population will multiply significantly. The state has 224 laws that criminalize homelessness. Too often homeless citizens are treated like dirt by law enforcement & their personal belongings often end up in the garbage. HB 2367 would prohibit law enforcement from enforcing any laws that violate the rights of anyone on public spaces. People should have: 1. The right to move freely, rest, sleep & be protected in public spaces without harassment or criminalization. 2. Right to occupy a legally parked vehicle. 3. Right to serve food & eat in public. 4. Right to legal counsel if being prosecuted. 5. Right to 24 hour access to hygiene facilities.
