

We wanted to enroll our 14 year old son in Summit Learning Charter. The main reason we wanted to switch schools was the bullying that has gone on since 5th grade. It was so bad he ended up being suicidal and received counseling for a year. Our 2 older boys (now 24 & 27) also dealt with bullying in Colton school district. When the district denied our appeal to attend Summit, we were denied because of the 3% cap. The other reason we wanted to transfer him to Summit is because they have over 200 different classes to choose from including, programming, coding, robotics, etc.. These are all classes that my son wants to pursue and Colton is extremely limited on their electives. I believe Colton only has 5-6 elective options which are journalism, choir, band, and I am not sure of the others since my son is not attending Colton this year. Summit is accredited by Advanced ED and has certified teachers. They began in 2008 therefore they have more experience in online curriculum than Colton. They also tailor the curriculum to meet the needs of every student and their unique learning style.
