

Dear House Rules Committee Members,

We oppose HB 2679!

The Oregon Constitution says you need to be 18 years of age to vote.

"Section 2. Qualifications of electors. (1) Every citizen of the United States is entitled to vote in all elections not otherwise provided for by this Constitution if such citizen:

(a) Is 18 years of age or older;"

While we respect young people younger than 18, they have not met the age requirement to vote.
