

Hello, I'd like to speak in opposition to this bill.

Allowing jurisdictions other than the State of Oregon to make gun laws violates the Oregon State Constitution.

Creating a patchwork of gun laws violates the 2nd Amendment to the United States Constitution as it infringes on an individual's right to bear arms. Additionally it violates the 5th Amendment to the US Constitution, in that it deprives a person of their 2nd Amendment rights without Due Process of Law.

Persons in Oregon with Concealed Handgun Licenses are some of the most law-abiding citizens in the state and are not involved in criminal activity. They have to pass FBI background check, including fingerprinting, to get CHL and have to do the same everytime they renew their CHL.
